

# RENTING A DUMPSTER?



## Some Things You Should Know

- In Nova Scotia many different materials are banned from disposal (see list below).
- Any person who generates waste is required to sort all waste and store it separately for pick-up to make sure the banned items do not end up in a landfill.
- Commercial dumpsters may be dedicated for individual materials such as cardboard, recyclables or compostable organics, but if the dumpster is designated for garbage it cannot contain the following banned materials:
  - Automobile Tires
  - Hazardous Waste like Pesticides, Cleaners, Paint, etc.
  - Food Waste, Leaves, and/or Brush
  - Cardboard
  - Newsprint and other Recyclable Paper
  - Beverage Containers
  - Tin cans, Glass Jars and Plastic Containers
  - TVs, Computers, and other Recyclable Electronics
  - Propane Tanks
- If a dumpster is designated for Construction and Demolition (C&D) materials to be trucked to a C&D disposal site, nothing but construction and demolition materials may be placed inside.
